



About the Project:

Reem Al Mealla, a PhD candidate and part of the Coral Reef Research Unit at the University of Essex, is currently looking for one to two volunteers to help conduct dive surveys in Bahrain to examine the health of coral reefs through assessing the carbonate budget production and erosion in May 2017 along with some genetic studies. This fieldwork is part of Reem's thesis project focused on understanding whether coral reefs in Bahrain harbour a symbiotic partnership that will enable regional reef accretion in a future predicted to overcome global reef bleaching. The ideal candidate is someone with a background in environmental sciences or related fields interested in coral reef ecology and looking to gain some research/field experience.

Work commitment: 10 days of field work in May 2017. From Monday Sunday starting early morning until late evening. Exact time and day may vary depending on tides and winds.

 > Must be a certified PADI Diver

 > Must have a minimum of 50 dives logged

 > Must be able to be flexible, a team player and be oble to follow instructions as given

 > Must be physically fit to undertake the required work underwater
